Feedback on progress is minimal	We hold a parents' evening in the Autumn and Spring terms and send interim reports to parents at the end of Autumn and Spring. An annual report is provided each year. Progress is shared and discussed at each of these meetings.
Lots of text messages received even on non-working days	We use our text service to ensure that families are well informed of events concerning their child. We do schedule some text at weekends and in the holidays to ensure families can be prepared for Monday events.

Children should not receive homework over the holidays	Homework is always a contentious issue. We try to provide a range of homework so that those who want their child to do more, can.
We would appreciate a little more notice for some things to allow for planning	We are aware that some communication can happen last minute or unduly close to events taking place. We will try to improve this system. Sometimes we are not given enough time to plan ahead ourselves due to school being informed of events last minute.
