Uniform Policy

Uniform policy at Healey Foundation Primary School.

Our aim is that our school uniform is as cost effective as possible, whilst being practical.

We would like all children to wear full school uniform. A school uniform ensures that everybody looks the same, feels part of a team and is included. Uniform practical and hard wearing for all the activities pupils take part in whilst in school.

The uniform is:

- A blue school jumper, cardigan or fleece. These can be branded with the school logo or bought without the school logo.
- A white polo shirt – with the school logo or without.
- Grey trousers, skirts or pinafores.
- White, black, grey socks/tights.
- Black school shoes – no laces please in the early years. NOT crocs or jelly shoes.
- Summer dresses – blue gingham dresses.
- All clothing MUST have the child's name in.
- Indoor PE – Pumps, white t-shirt and black shorts.
- Outdoor PE/games – trainers, joggers or leggings, t-shirt and sweatshirt. No football tops are allowed and shoulders must be covered.

All of our branded uniform can be purchased from the school uniform retailers in Rochdale. All the major supermarkets have uniform which matches our school colours and can be purchased at reasonable prices a certain times of the year. There is no expectation that pupils have to wear our branded uniform.

At the end of each term, we will accept any old uniform into school to recycle. This will be washed and then we will inform parents of any uniform we have and this will be given free to parents who need it. This will be done sensitively.

Appearance:

Hair –

- Hair must be worn back in a tidy plait or ponytail.

Jewellery –

- No jewellery should be worn apart from a small watch or stud earrings.
