Changes to Healey School PE lesson and PE kit.

From January 2026 we will be changing the way our PE lessons work at Healey.

On the days when your child has PE they will be able to come to school in their PE kit – this way the pupils are already dressed for their lesson. There is no lost lesson time due to changing into and out of PE kit, there is also less likelihood of parts of your child's school uniform going missing whilst changing for PE.

On PE days pupils must come to school in a white t shirt, black shorts (warm days) jogging bottoms/leggings (cold days, outdoors) and pumps/trainers

Pupils must wear a new Healey hoody or their school jumper/cardigan.

Healey School PE Hoodies are now available at Moses Schoolware for £13.99 – get them now in time for the start of the Spring term.

Our pupils will be able to wear our fantastic new school hoodies on their PE days.

Christmas Dinner!

On Thursday 11th of December pupils will be having a Christmas Dinner.

Pupils in Key Stage 2 (Year 3 upwards) must pay for their school dinner if they usually have sandwiches. Pupils who always have a school dinner will get a dinner on this day.

To book a Christmas Dinner for your child you simply pay for a school dinner using the school gateway app – the cost of a dinner is £2.85.

Pupils in Key Stage 1 (Reception to Year 2) get Christmas Dinner for free however if your child usually has sandwiches and you would like them to have a Christmas Dinner please let the office know.

Booking Before/After School Club places from January 2026.

From January our booking system for the Before and After School club will be changing – it will be going completely digital through the school gateway app.

Places in the club will have to be booked and paid for upfront using the app – it is therefore important that you have the app set up on your phone in order to be able to book the sessions you need.

There will be 40 places available in a morning and 40 places available after school. Once the club is full no further bookings will be able to be made.

Any cancellations to booked places must be made 24hrs beforehand to ensure a refund/credit is returned to the app.

Government vouchers will be accepted but bookings must still be made for your child.
