Booking Before/After School Club places.

Our booking system for the Before and After School club is now completely digital and accessible through the school gateway app.

Places in the club will have to be booked and paid for upfront using the app – it is therefore important that you have the app set up on your phone in order to be able to book the sessions you need.

There will be 40 places available in a morning and 40 places available after school. Once the club is full no further bookings will be able to be made.

Any cancellations to booked places must be made 24hrs beforehand to ensure a refund/credit is returned to the app.
